Course 1: What's new in Pharmacology in the dental practice by Dr. Christine Quinn

From 9:00 A.M. -12:00 Noon – 3.0 C.E. Units

This lecture will cover what's new in Pharmacology in dental practice, premedication, including an overview of the management of anticoagulated patient in the dental practice, including a look at the new anticoagulants. Other topics to be covered include a look at oral sedation. There will also be discussion concerning the format of a proper medical consultation.

Dr. Quinn received her D.D.S. degree from the University Of Southern California School Of Dentistry in 1987 and completed a residency in Dental Anesthesiology at the Ohio State University College of Dentistry in 1989. Dr. Quinn is currently Clinical Professor of Anesthesiology in the Division of Diagnostic and Surgical Sciences at the UCLA School of Dentistry. She is actively involved with both didactic and clinical teaching at the pre-doctoral and postdoctoral levels at the UCLA School of Dentistry. Dr. Quinn is an in-office examiner for the State of California for general anesthesia. Dr. Quinn serves on the Board of Directors for the California Dental Society of Anesthesiology and is the President of the American Society of Dentist Anesthesiologists. She is also a member of the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology. Besides being actively involved in research on pain and anxiety control, Dr. Quinn also maintains a part-time private practice limited to dental anesthesiology.
